Creating A Buzz..


Heather McNiven a local beekeeper came along and educated us on the importance and impact bees have on our environment.



Do you love reading? Sometimes wish you had someone to discuss your latest book with? Well, our very own Reading Group is just what you need.



We are really pleased to announce that we raised £150 for Ditch The Slippers.




Stash Sale

The Crafty Diva ladies have been having a great time creating quite a few masterpieces.


